In 2008, the Soup Kitchen was inspired by the spirit of Kenneth Butler who was once a fire chief in Greenfield. He was a man who dedicated his time to helping those in need through truck-stop ministries, prison ministries, and taking in homeless people. In his honor, the Kenneth Butler Memorial Soup Kitchen (KBMSK) opened its doors in Greenfield in 2009.

In 2019, the Soup Kitchen will celebrate a decade of providing nutritious meals. This milestone event is complemented by the desire of our organization to continue doing this important work for many years to come. While immediate needs are of constant concern, the future sustainability of the work of the Soup Kitchen is vitally important. In April of 2015, the Board of Directors established The Kenneth Butler Memorial Soup Kitchen Operating Endowment. The endowment, a component fund of the Hancock County Community Foundation, can be compared to a savings account or a retirement account...an account where money is saved, invested, and grows over time. A portion of the income generated from this fund provides annual unrestricted support for day to day operations and services.
